- All Ages Home Group alternate Thursdays

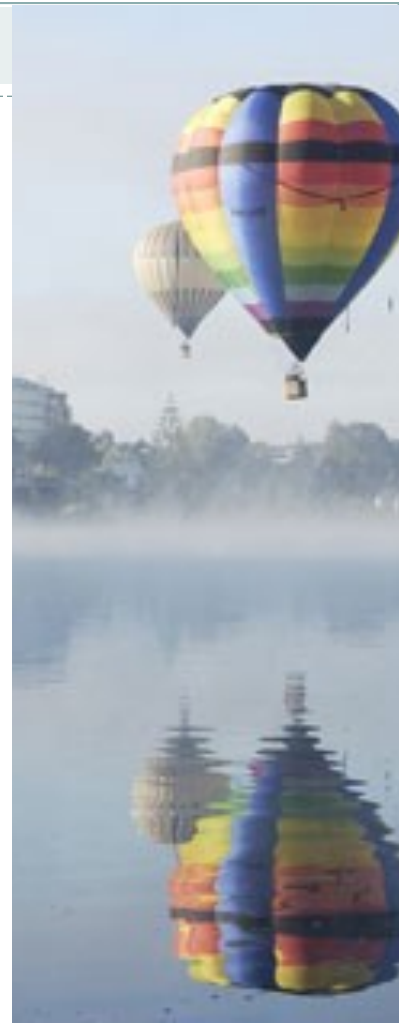
We also have a number of Fellowship groups that meet fortnightly or monthly:

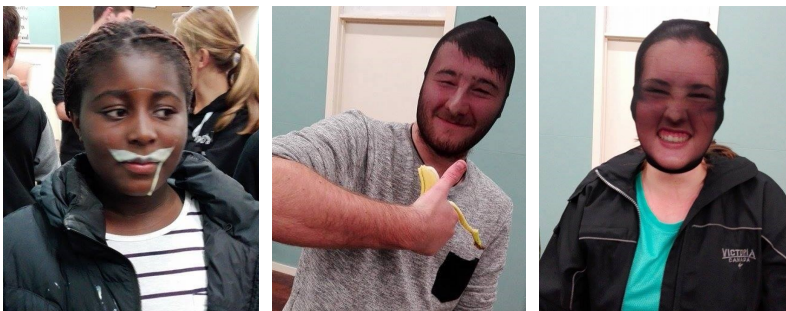
